Minutes of the Propstoppers Model Airplane Club October 11, 2011

At the Middletown library

The following notes are based on recollections from officers present:

Approximately 14 people in attendance, which brought about a discussion as to whether we should identify a list of inactive members and try to sell them a limited membership (non-flying). It was mentioned that they still would have to be AMA members. Perhaps we could sell them a subsccription to the minutes, thereby making up some of the lost membership fees.

We then discusse what to do about poison ivy at the Elwyn field. Dave Bevan read a long list of recommended chemicals from several sources. Missouri Dept Conservation recommended Glyphosate as in Roundup, Kleenup but they are non selective, that is they kill grass too. There is a poison ivy, oak and sumac info center and they say to use Ortho Brush be Gone triclopyr which is effective on woody plants with little kill on grass family plants- much better than Round Up, which often doesn't work! Also ammonium sulfateammate- extremely selective, killing only poison ivy. The University of Oklahoma recommended for poison ivy, toxicodendron radicans control with glyphosate as in Weedazole, Amitrole, but that kills grass. Using 2,4,D Triclopyr does not kill grass. Weed be Gone, Jet Weeder contain 2,4,D are not the most effective on P.I. but won't kill grass. Garlon, Redeem, Brush be Gone(Triclopyr) does not affect grasses. Crossbow is a mixture of 2,4,D and Triclopyr. For non residential use: Banvel, Velpar, Tordon, Oust. Iowa State said Glyphosate sold as Roundup or Kleenup are non selective, ie, kill grasses. Growth regulator herbicides do not kill grasses -2,4,D, 2,4,DP(dichlorprop) Dicamba are triclopyr Other forestry depts and landscaper gave essentially the same data. It was agreed that before treating the site , we should ask Pete Thomas, the Elwyn property man who is letting us use the field, if he has any EPA or other concerns about us treating the field.
